

It results in the death or chronic disability of many active younger people, especially those involved in farming and plantation work. The incidence of snake-bite mortality is particularly high in Tribal area.

We have successfully organized "Snake Bite Awareness Program" on 30th September 2022 in a community of Kondhval, Bhimashankar to minimize the snake bite rate and make people aware about snake bite management. The program was done for community people who are unknown about its preventive measures. This program aimed to provide sufficient practical information to know about snake bite management.

We have also described about the venomous Snakes of India, their classification and ideas to identify venomous and non-venomous snakes. The people were curious to learn.

From this program, people are known about identification of snakes, signs and symptoms of snake bite and its management and first aid etc. People have known that snakes are important for this ecosystem and people are more
