- 6) The impact of social media on mental health.

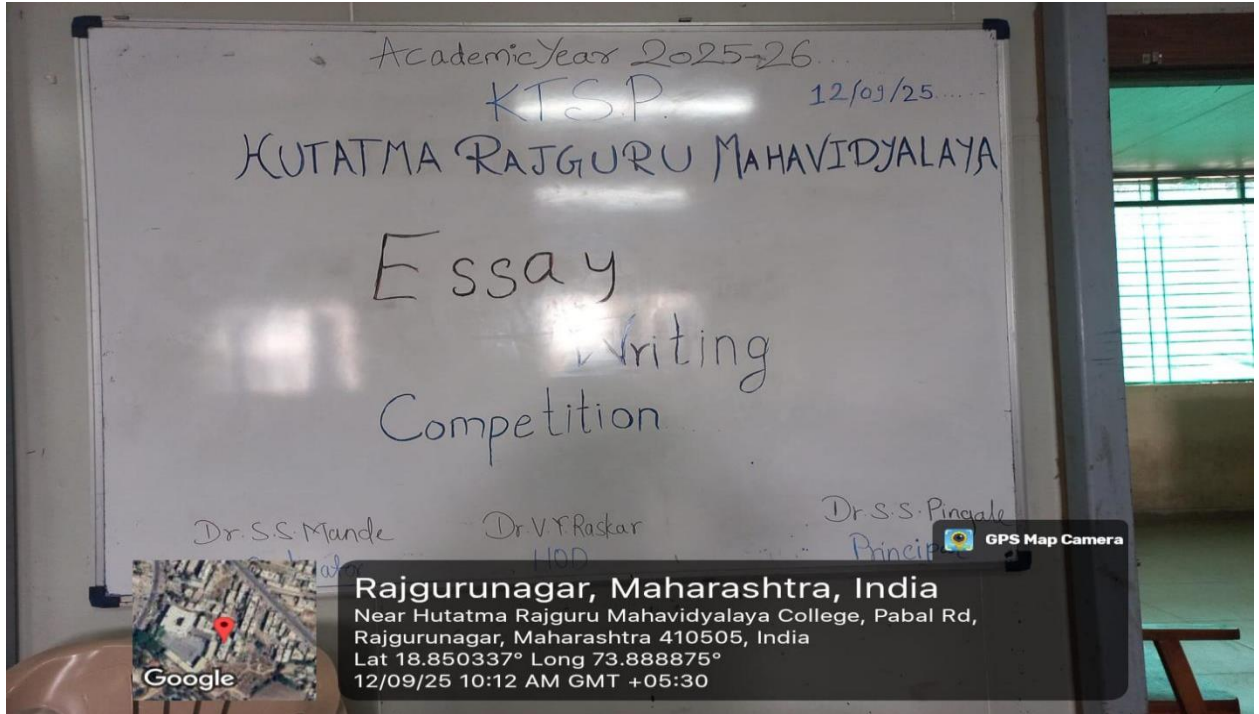

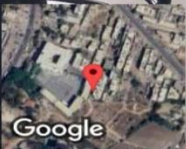
