Report on Poetry Recitation

The Department of English of Hutatma Rajguru Mahavidyalaya, Rajgurunagar organized a vibrant Poetry Recitation Competition on 14th October 2024 at 11:00 a.m. in the English Language Laboratory. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from department of English, offering them an opportunity to share their favorite poetic verses and express their appreciation for the beauty of language through performance. The primary objective of the event was to celebrate poetry as a creative and expressive art form. It served as a platform for students to showcase their love for literature, enhance their presentation skills and connect emotionally with the power of spoken words. Some chose to recite classic poems by poets such as William Wordsworth, Robert Frost and Emily Dickinson, while others chose modern voices like Maya Angelou or shared their own poetic compositions. The atmosphere was filled with lyrical beauty, reflective thoughts and heartfelt applause. The event concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Prof. S.S. Bhogade, who expressed gratitude to the organizing committee, faculty members and all the participants for their spirited involvement and support. She acknowledged the effort put in by the students in preparing for the event and commended their talent and enthusiasm. Overall, the Poetry Recitation Competition was a resounding success. It not only allowed students to delve into the expressive world of poetry but also reinforced the department's commitment to nurturing literary appreciation, creativity, and linguistic confidence among students.






