Devbag Beach

First day we visit to Devbag Beach, the sea water is very clear. The beach is surrounded by lush greenery & surrounded by the beautiful nature. The loose sediments, scarce freshwater & highly saline conditions are difficult to live for plants but few species live. Students collected different types of shells & Hermit crab, starfish and various type of Bivalve observed on beach.

Devbag sangam is nothing but the confluence of the Karli River and the Arabian Sea. This sangam makes the beach more lovely and beautiful. The beach sand will be white and surrounded by water from three sides. The clear blue sea water, the mangrove trees and exotic bird species makes the beach more enticing.

As Tarkarli (Devbag) is a scuba destination of Maharashtra, It is best to know the basic scuba diving, so that you can explore many things under the sea.

Rock Garden

Next, we visited to Rock Garden. The Rock Garden in Malvan is a unique creation made entirely of rocks. It features sculptures, pathways, and seating areas made from stones and shells. Here stunning rock formations observed, & The rocks are really huge.

Jai Ganesh Temple

Next we visited to *Ganesha* temple which is the beautifully architect temple, the temple is designed and built in a typical Maharashtrian style. Here we attened *Arati* of lord Ganesha. The main idol appears to be with the consorts (Riddhi and Siddhi) and is made of gold.

Second Day 19 Feb 2024

On Second day place near Devbag, We first took the boat for a 1 hrs. in that time Period we Our boatman took us various attractive and biodiversity point:

- *Sangam*, **point:** Confluence of the Karli River and the Arabian Sea. This *sangam* makes the Area more lovely and beautiful.
- Sea Bird island: The island become visible after some time passes in morning and then you can see Seagull birds although this place is for bird.
- Crocodile Point: The thing is, there are no crocodiles there but it is called so, because when you look at this point from a distance, it looks like an alligator.
- Nivati Rock
- Golden Rock: a rock that turns golden when sunlight falls on it.
- Dolphin point: It is very close to Tsunami Island and visitors are taken by boats to the point.

Tsunami Island

Then we visited the tsunami island. Tsunami island appeared in the year 2004 when tsunami waves hit the Indian ocean. It is located in the delta of the Tarkarli River near devbagh. The beach is near the island and gets partly submerged in the water during high tide and monsoons.

Sindhudurg Fort:

This historic fort is situated on an island off the coast of Malvan. It was built by the Maratha ruler, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, and is known for its architectural marvels and scenic surroundings.

After a successful field visit all of us returned at Mahavidyalaya Campus and then dispersed. The tour gave a good exposure to biodiversity for everyone and was a good study experience.
