


**Feedback Action Taken Report (2021-22)**


The college utilized multiple parameters to collect feedback on the syllabus from a variety of stakeholders including students, teachers, alumni, and employers. The feedback was carefully analyzed and consolidated into an analysis report, with particular attention given to the concerns raised by the students. The Head of Department reviewed and assessed the suggestions with the concerned teachers, and subsequently communicated them to the Board of Studies at Savitribai Phule Pune University; Pune. The college conducted a comprehensive feedback collection exercise on the syllabus from students across all courses. The collected data was carefully sorted, consolidated, and analyzed, with a particular focus on the suggestions put forth by the students.

Our teachers actively participated in the Syllabus Revision Workshops, where they were advised to consider the suggestions made by the students. Many of our faculties have been participating actively in the syllabus restructuring process. For instance, Prof. Dr. Kailas Sonawane of our faculty is a Member of the Board of Studies in Political Science, Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune. Dr. Vikas Raskar of our faculty is also a Member of BOS in English, Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune. Prof. Dr. Rajendra Shirasi of our faculty worked as the Member of the Sub Committee of restructuring Syllabus for T.Y.B. Com. in Banking Finance and Insurance BOS Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune.


