AIDS Awareness Rally - 1st December 2022.

NSS unit of Hutatma Rajguru Mahavidyalaya, Rajgurunagar, Rural Hospital, Chandoli and Red Ribbon Club jointly organized Global AIDS Day awareness rally on 1st Dec. 2022. The purpose of the event was to raise awareness about AIDS, educate the community about prevention strategies, and promote a compassionate and inclusive society. The rally commenced at Hutatma Rajguru Mahavidyalaya, Rajgurunagar with enthusiastic participation from NSS volunteers. A total of 100 volunteers gathered at the venue, dressed in their white tops with black bottoms, symbolizing unity and teamwork. The event coordinators ensured that all necessary equipment, such as banners, placards, pamphlets, and other materials, were available for the participants. The rally route covered major streets and areas of Rajgurunagar, allowing the volunteers to reach a wide audience.
