REPORT

A Cyber Security Awareness Campaign was held at Hutatma Rajguru College, highlighting the importance of cyber safety in today's technology-driven world. API Snehal Gurav from Khed Police Station addressed the students on the topic of "Cyber Security" under the college's National Service Scheme (NSS). She emphasized the need to understand cyber security to ensure safety in daily. API Gurav pointed out that cybercrime has seen a sharp rise in recent years. To combat this, it is crucial for students to stay alert. She advised against sharing personal or banking information with anyone on social media. She also cautioned against downloading unnecessary apps on mobile phones and granting them access to sensitive data. Extra caution should be exercised while conducting banking transactions. She also highlighted that stalking someone via social media is a punishable offense and that the government has introduced strict laws since 2005 to tackle cybercrime, imposing severe penalties. She urged students to stay vigilant and avoid involvement in cybercrimes. The program concluded with a presidential address by Principal Dr. Shirish Pingale. Dr. Prabhakar Jagtap delivered the introductory remarks, while Ms. Divya Pingale served

as the event's compere. Ms. Shrutika Walunj introduced the guest speaker, and Prof. Jayashree Gogawale expressed the vote of thanks.
