Report

The Hutatma Rajguru Mahavidyalaya organized an Avishkar competition on 15th September 2022. A total of 40 students from Science Arts and Commerce faculty presented their projects. There are total 6 categories in Avishkar. The students participated from 4 categories like Pure Science, Agriculture and animal husbandry, Commerce management and Law and Humanities, languages and fine arts.

The program was inaugurated at 10.30 am by the hands of Principal Dr. S.S. Pingale in the presence of Dr. S. D. Shinde (Vice Principal Arts Faculty), Dr. R. S. Shirsi (Head, Department of Economics), Dr. P. S. Kulkarni (IQAC coordinator), Dr. G. M. Dhumal (Head, Dept. of Commerce) and Prof. D.N. Birhade (Head, Dept. of Zoology).

A total of 20 projects were on display which included Plant based meat, Smart street light, Phytochemical studies of *Oroxylum indicum*, a rare indigenous plant, Biodegradable pots, Traffic Management etc. The distinguished guests went through the displayed projects with much enthusiasm and curiosity and asked in detail about the preparation, uses, cost-effectiveness etc. of the various projects. A large number of students showed their presence and took firsthand experience.

The projects were evaluated by judging committee consisted of Dr. R. S. Shirsi (Head, Department of Economics), Dr. P. S. Kulkarni (IQAC coordinator) and Dr. G. M. Dhumal

(Head, Dept. of Commerce). The committee scrutinized each projects on the basis of relevance, methodology, contribution, innovativeness, and outcome. On the basis of evaluation “Smart Street light system” and “Eco-friendly paper sheet from weeds” were selected from Pure Science category. “Bio anti Insfungo Bactoside” and “Organic fertilization- *Eichhornia*” were selected from Agriculture and animal husbandry. “Aspects of Globalization in Jhumpa Lahiri’s “The Namesake” project selected from Humanities, languages and fine arts. The selected project abstracts and posters sent to Savitribai Phule Pune University for further selection at zonal level.
