Report on Debate Competition

The Language Lab Cell of Hutatma Rajguru Mahavidyalaya, Rajgurunagar organized an intellectually stimulating Debate Competition on 30th September 2024 at 10:45 a.m. in the Department of English. The event was meticulously planned to foster critical thinking, articulate communication and respectful exchange of ideas among students. The debate competition provided a unique platform for students to refine their public speaking and persuasive communication skills, while also enhancing their ability to engage in constructive dialogue. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from students across various streams, offering them an opportunity to showcase their talent. The event began with a brief inaugural session initiated by Dr. V.Y.Raskar, Dr. S.S. Mande and Prof. V.D. Kathe, who welcomed the participants and emphasized the importance of such co-curricular activities in nurturing academic and interpersonal skills. They also highlighted how debates serve as powerful tools for encouraging independent thought and civic engagement, especially in an age dominated by digital information and diverse viewpoints. The topic of the debate was: “Is Online Education as Effective as Traditional Classroom Learning?” This theme was highly relevant in the post-pandemic educational context and sparked a vibrant exchange of perspectives. Participants were divided into two teams-For and Against the motion and were given adequate time to prepare and present their arguments. Each team presented well-researched points supported by data, real-life examples and logical reasoning. Students arguing in favour of online education highlighted its flexibility, accessibility and integration of technology that enables self-paced learning. They stressed the benefits of digital resources, recorded lectures and remote collaboration. On the other hand, those opposing the motion emphasized the irreplaceable role of face-to-face interaction, teacher-student bonding, classroom discipline and real-time feedback in traditional learning environments. The arguments reflected the depth of preparation and clarity of thought among the participants. The debate was not only a test of content knowledge but also of spontaneity, listening ability and respectful disagreement. Participants demonstrated commendable poise in countering opposing views, acknowledging the merits of alternate opinions and defending their stand under time pressure. The audience, comprising students and faculty members, listened attentively and appreciated the efforts of the speakers through applause and thoughtful questions during the interactive session. The panel of judges, consisting of teachers from the English Department, assessed the participants based on content, delivery, confidence, clarity and skills. They praised the students for their active involvement and urged them to continue participating in such intellectually enriching activities. The event concluded with a formal vote of thanks, acknowledging the contributions of the organizing committee, participating students, faculty and volunteers who made the event a grand

success. Overall, the Debate Competition organized by the Language Lab Cell served as a meaningful academic exercise and received an overwhelming response from the students.
