Report on Film Screening and Appreciation Program

A two-day Film Screening and Appreciation event was organized on 25th and 26th February 2025 by the Language Lab Cell in collaboration with Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at Hutatma Rajguru Mahavidyalaya, Rajgurunagar. The event aimed to enhance students' understanding of cinema as an art form and to develop their analytical and interpretative skills through guided film appreciation. The program was inaugurated by Dr. P.S. Kulkarni, IQAC Coordinator, who addressed the students and highlighted the educational value of films in exploring themes, narratives and cultural contexts. He emphasized how film appreciation can serve as a powerful tool for critical thinking and aesthetic development. The inaugural session was concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Dr. V. Y. Raskar.

Two films were screened during the event:

1. *The Pen* (2018) – a thought-provoking short film directed by Che Deedigan, Conor Deedigan, and Ynez Myers, offering a poignant message through minimalist storytelling.
2. *Coco* (2017) – an award-winning American animated fantasy comedy-drama produced by Pixar Animation Studios and directed by Lee Unkrich, celebrated for its vibrant visuals and deep emotional themes surrounding family and memory.

Following each screening, discussion and appreciation sessions were held, where students enthusiastically shared their interpretations, insights and emotional responses. These interactive sessions encouraged students to view cinema as more than entertainment, appreciating it as a medium for expression, social commentary and cultural exploration. The event witnessed active participation from students across various disciplines and the feedback was overwhelmingly positive. Students expressed that the experience was both enjoyable and intellectually stimulating, providing a fresh perspective on films and storytelling techniques. Overall, the program successfully fulfilled its objective of integrating film appreciation into academic enrichment and fostering a deeper understanding of cinematic art among students.





Film Screening and Appreciation.


