BOTANICAL GARDEN AND CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT REPORT

The botanical survey of the HRM campus was carried out under the guidance of the Botanical Garden and Campus Development Committee in collaboration with the Department of Botany. The purpose of this survey was to assess the existing plant diversity, evaluate the impact of ongoing infrastructural development, and plan for the conservation and enhancement of the campus green cover.

During the survey, a detailed observation and documentation of plant species present across the campus were conducted. It was recorded that the campus maintains a different varieties of plants, most of which are ornamental in nature. These plants significantly contribute to the aesthetic beauty and environmental quality of the campus.

Efforts are being consistently made by the Botanical Garden Committee and the Department of Botany to restore and enhance the greenery within the available limited space. Regular maintenance practices such as watering, pruning, and care of plants are followed to sustain plant health. The committee is also focused on promoting awareness about plant conservation among students and staff.

In the future, there are plans to restore and develop the Botanical Garden with a diverse collection of rare and endangered species along with medicinal, ornamental, and fruit-bearing plants.
